


In closing hope to see you in 2020 at Mid-Year as well as at Imperial Session in Kansas City, Mo.

"It is a requirement that shrine treasurers be on ALL unit, club, committee (UCC) accounts"

I would like to address a mandate from Imperial which may be overlooked by a number of Shrines. It is a requirement that shrine treasurers be on ALL unit, club, committee (UCC) accounts. If your Shrine isn't complying with the requirement, now is the time to start planning on implementing it next year.

The explanation you can use on your UCCs is simple. It isn't to take their funds. As they fall under the umbrella of their individual Shrine, their funds are already the Shrine's funds.

That's one of the reasons every UCC files their taxes under the Shrine.

One reason is to give the individual

UCCs the ability to conduct business in the event their treasurer passes away. We had this happen in my Shrine.

We had a member whom I'll call John. John and his wife, Jane, were very active members. They attended most of the functions, even attending numerous Imperial sessions.

I know John was treasurer in at least two units or clubs. when he passed away, did they find out he was the only signature on the accounts. While the units and clubs could continue with their meetings, they couldn't pay bills or donate. Depending on the frequency of their meetings, it could take 1-3 months before they elected a new treasurer. With the Shrine's treasurer on the account signature card (S), they would be able to conduct business as usual until the election of a new treasurer.

Another reason is a unit or club going dark. When this happens, the assets are usually liquidated and given to the Shrine or a charitable donation is made, normally to the hospital fund, a specific hospital or Imperial. However, occasionally not all the assets are liquidated or an account may have been overlooked. With the shrine's treasurer listed on the account, the problem is quickly resolved and a great deal of paperwork eliminated.

The major problem with putting the shrine's treasurer on all the UCC accounts isn't necessarily with the UCCs. It's with the financial institutions being used. Because of the size of the territory each Shrine covers, I doubt every UCC in any one Shrine's territory is handled by just one financial institution. I know there may be several exceptions, but most of the Shrines cover hundreds, if not thousands of miles.

Each institution used has rules and regulations they must follow. Will a bank allow you to sign from your home location or do you need to go to the bank itself and sign? I'm fortunate as my farthest location is only 130-140 miles away, not 500+ like some Shrines. They may also require a resolution authorizing the name addition. This may be covered by the minutes of the respective UCC. An-

other way would be for the Shrine to issue a letter explaining the Imperial's requirement and as Chief Financial Officer of the Shrine you are already an ex officio member of all UCCs and are requires to be on the accounts.

In closing, if your Shrine isn't requiring the Treasurer to be on ALL accounts, now is the time to start getting your Shrine in compliance. If the paperwork is done before the elections in December, the treasurer should be able to start the New Year with minimal issues.

The attendance at the Seminar has been less than desired, somewhere in the range

of 45 to 60 for the past several years.

That is only about 27% of the Treasurers.

A consistent argument for not attending has been that many of members are involved with the tax season. With the Seminar being held so close to April 15 it was difficult for many to take time off from their work to attend. By moving the Seminar to the beginning of March this should help with that issue.

As I mentioned earlier 'A DECADE' of going to Tampa has put us in a 'RUT'.

Many of the other Shrine Associations move their meetings to different areas of the country. This not only changes the scenery but balances the cost a little for those who are not close to Tampa.

Tampa has been very good to us in the past with concessions from the Hotel and the availability of Headquarters Staff to attend our Seminars. But when we met with the Hotel to plan for 2020, the concessions had all gone away, and when we finally received their proposal, the room rate had increased by almost 20%.

It is imperative that conversations take place this year on the options in front of us regarding Session costs, headquarter expenses and the potential need to raise dues.
